Previously, WHO experts stated that mortality from hepatitis could increase by 65% by 2030.

The mortality rate from this disease is rising. In 2022, the number of deaths from viral hepatitis globally will increase to 1.3 million, compared to 1.1 million in 2019, the authors note. Experts predict that if the situation continues unabated, the number of new hepatitis infections will increase by 90% by 2030, and the mortality rate will increase by 65%.

According to the official website of the World Health Organization (WHO), hepatitis is an inflammation of the liver that can cause a range of health problems and can be fatal.

There are five main strains of the hepatitis virus, called types A, B, C, D, and E. All cause liver disease, but there are significant differences between them, including how the virus is transmitted, the severity of the disease, its geographic distribution, and prevention methods.

In particular, types B and C cause chronic disease in hundreds of millions of people and are the most common cause of cirrhosis and liver cancer. Hepatitis B and/or C is estimated to affect approximately 325 million people worldwide, and for most of these
